Staffing

School Photos

The photographer is coming on Friday 6th October. All children will be individually photographed and all siblings in school will be photographed together. If you have younger children and would like them photographing, please let the office know. Please note we only photograph children and their younger siblings, not any other family members, thank you.

<u>Earrings</u>

These cannot be worn for swimming or PE and staff are not allowed to remove them. Please ensure that if your child has their ears pierced they are removed before they come to school on a day when they have any of these activities if they cannot remove them without assistance. It is much appreciated if ears are pierced at the beginning of the long summer holiday and they practise taking them out before they come back to school.

<u>PE</u>

Please be aware that **all** children need trainers in their PE kit as well as a pair of plimsolls. As the weather is already quite cool they also need a pair of joggers/ leggings and sweatshirt to do PE in. Children do PE outside as much as possible.

School Fruit

KS1 children are provided with free fruit for snack time as part of a government initiative. The school pays for fruit for KS2 so every child has a piece.

It will make paying for trips, booking parents evening appointments and reporting absences much easier for you.
