Mark 14 and 15 together describe the final days of Jesus' life, from his anointing at Bethany and the preparation for the Passover to his betrayal, arrest, trial, crucifixion, death, and burial. Key events include Jesus predicting Peter's denial, his arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane, his trial before the Sanhedrin and Pontius Pilate, and his death on the cross at Golgotha.
