This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils' music education.

Music is taught to all pupils, including those with SEND, in each class every week using Lincolnshire Music Service Scheme. Lessons are a minimum of 40 minutes and are taught by class teachers. Teaching is supported by scheme planning from the Lincolnshire Music Scheme. This musical learning is further supplemented by weekly singing Collective Worship sessions in each key stage, lasting 15-20 minutes.

Within the scheme, children are taught to sing a variety of songs, some of which they learn to play on either the glockenspiel or recorder as well as some percussion instruments.

Part B: Extra-curricular music

Whilst in previous years we have run an afterschool club for the Young Voices Choir, this year had no extra curricular music arrangements

Last year we sang remembrance songs at the village War Memorial and had a local bugler play the last post.

Annual Carols around the Tree at Christmas time in which families are invited to join the children to sing traditional carols outside.

Part C: Musical experiences

For the past four year, KS2 children have the chance to take part in Young Voices each year and this year they will also get the chance to sing in the Lincolnshire Music Festival.

This year, KS2 children will also be performing songs and dances in the end of year play in front of parents and friends of the school. Ks1 children performed in their nativity in the church.

Blue class attended the Church School's Festival in Lincoln Cathedral and sang songs learnt that day in the service.

In the future

We intend to apply for Young Voices again next year.

We will also be investigating the desire to learn musical instruments with an external teacher to offer the opportunity to those that may be interested.
