<p>Can you make up or learn a song about London? You could use the tune of <i>The Wheels on the Bus</i> but start with 'I went to the city, and I saw...'</p> 	<p>We'd like to find out more about you. If you could go to any city in the world, which city would it be? What would you like to see and do? Maybe you have visited this city before?</p>	<p>Can you design and make a model of London? You could use Lego, junk, modelling clay or anything else you like?</p> 
<p>Create a 2D city shape picture of London. Can you label the shape names? Create a scrapbook of your favourite cities and include pictures, labels, captions.</p> 

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
