Harvest festival

This year, we are celebrating Harvest on Wednesday 9th October. You are welcome to join us at the church at 9 am.

As part of our harvest this year, we are supporting the food bank - Destiny Outreach Coningsby.

Destiny Outreach Coningsby was established nearly three years ago. Donations are collected from the Married Quarters at RAF Coningsby as well as the three collection points at Coningsby & Tattershall Lincolnshire Co-Ops and RAF Coningsby Spar shop.

From there, all food is stored in RAF Coningsby. Referrals are received from local authorities such as schools, doctors, and citizen's advice. A food parcel is then delivered to the person in need. Food parcels are catered to the household size and are the size to sustain the household for a minimum of three days but will usually stretch longer.

We are asking for donations of food to be brought into school that week to be sent to the food bank. Please can these be canned or dried items, nothing fresh. A letter with more details will be sent nearer the time.
